

Contest Rules and Regulations

Expo Rendez-Voile 2026

- 1. Contest Organizer** This contest is organized by **Expo Rendez-Voile Inc.**, in collaboration with its partners and prize providers.
- 2. Eligibility** The contest is open to any person aged 18 and over residing in Canada at the time of entry. Directors, officers, and representatives of the organization, as well as any person residing with them, are excluded.
- 3. Contest Period** The contest begins and ends on **April 18, 2026, from 11:00 AM to 8:00 PM**. Any entry received after this time will not be eligible.
- 4. How to Enter** No purchase is required to participate. To enter, participants must complete the entry form available by:
 - Scanning the QR code located in front of the Rendez-Voile entrance.

Participants must provide the following information:

- Last name
- First name
- Email address

Skill-Testing Question To be declared a winner, the selected person must correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question. Failure to answer correctly will result in a new draw.

Participants may also be invited to:

- Subscribe to the Expo Rendez-Voile and Voile Communautaire newsletter;
- Follow the event's Facebook page.

These actions are strictly optional and do not increase the chances of winning. **Limit of one entry per person.**

5. Prizes Several prizes will be offered by Expo Rendez-Voile partners. The description and approximate value of the prizes will be displayed on the event website in the dedicated contest section. Prizes must be accepted as awarded and cannot be exchanged or converted into cash. However, the organization reserves the right to substitute a prize with another of equivalent or greater value if a prize cannot be awarded as planned.

6. Draw Winners will be determined by a random draw from all eligible entries. The draw will take place after the event, on a date determined by the organization. Winners will be contacted by email at the address provided during registration. If a winner cannot be reached within **forty-eight (48) hours** of the first contact attempt, despite at least two (2) reasonable attempts, or if they fail to respond within this period, they will be disqualified and a new draw may be held.

7. Odds of Winning The odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received during the contest period. All participants automatically win attendance at a lecture given by Conam upon registration.

8. Use of Personal Information As part of their participation, participants must provide certain personal information, including their first name, last name, and email address. This information is collected by Expo Rendez-Voile Inc. for:

- Contest administration;
- Communication with participants and winners;
- Sending information regarding Expo Rendez-Voile, Voile Communautaire, and their activities.

With the participants' consent, this information may also be shared with partners and companies providing prizes, who may contact them for promotional or informative purposes. Personal information will be handled in accordance with applicable privacy laws, including the *Act respecting the protection of personal information in the private sector (Quebec)*, as amended by **Law 25**. Participants may request access to, rectification of, or deletion of their personal information by contacting the organization.

9. Limitation of Liability Expo Rendez-Voile, Voile Communautaire, their partners, sponsors, prize providers, and their respective directors, officers, volunteers, and representatives shall not be held liable for any damage, loss, or injury resulting from participation in the contest or the acceptance or use of a prize. The organization cannot be held responsible for lost, late, incomplete, or unreceived entries due to technical, computer, network problems, or any other failure beyond its control. The organization reserves the right to modify, suspend, or cancel the contest, in whole or in part, should a situation beyond its control compromise its proper conduct.

10. Fraud and Disqualification The organization reserves the right to disqualify any person who participates or attempts to participate in the contest by means contrary to these rules, including the use of fraudulent or automated means, or any attempt to manipulate the contest. Any entry deemed fraudulent, incomplete, or non-compliant may be cancelled.

11. Social Media This contest is not sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with Facebook, Instagram, or any other social media platform. The information provided by participants is collected by the Expo Rendez-Voile organization and not by social media platforms.

12. Final Decision Any decision by the organization regarding this contest is final and without appeal.

13. Acceptance of Rules Participation in the contest constitutes full and unconditional acceptance of these rules and regulations.
